FEES PAYABLE TO THE DEANERY

These fees are payable in respect of any service specified below, conducted by an Anglican priest, deacon or licensed lay minister.

Service in crematorium, parochial cemetery or other venue	112

Burial of ashes in parochial cemetery on separate occasion	- 56

NOTE: No fee is payable for the burial of a stillborn infant or persons aged under 18 years.

Fees for Retired Clergy

Each Sunday service	£ 50 (max. £100 per Sunday)
Each weekday service	£ 34
Separate baptisms	£ 50
Marriages	£162
Funerals	£ 84
Burial of body or ashes on separate occasion	£ 42

These fees are payable to clergy "with permission to officiate" only. Beneficed clergy, self-supporting ministers and licensed lay ministers are **not** entitled to a fee. All of the above fees may be claimed from the Treasurer of the church concerned but for funerals etc. held in a venue other than in an Anglican Church, the claim shall be submitted to the Deanery Treasurer.

Travel Expenses

Travel expenses should be offered to all clergy and readers officiating at services (other than funerals in respect of which specific provision is made) as follows:

- Car 66p per mile
- Motorcycle 33p per mile
- Bicycle 12p per mile

Chapels of St. Tugual, Christ The Healer & St. Apolline

For the purpose of this Table of Fees St. Tugual's Chapel, the Chapel of Christ The Healer and St. Apolline's Chapel shall be treated as if the service had taken place in the parish church of St. Peter Port, St. Andrew or St. Saviour, respectively.
