MANDATE

- (a) To initiate and advise on proposals; to ensure that members are adequately informed on questions raised and other matters of importance to the Deanery; to prepare the agenda; to transact the business of Synod between meetings; and to make such appointments and to do such things as the Synod may delegate to it.
- (b) To act as the Advisory and Legislative Committee of the Deanery Synod for the purposes of consultation with the Legislation Select Committee of the States of Guernsey in connection with the application of Measures to the Island under the Channel Islands (Church Legislation) Measure, 1931, as amended.
- (c) To monitor pastoral matters within the Deanery and to advise the Dean on matters of pastoral reorganization and deployment of resources within the Deanery.
